Calling all Stoughton High School students looking to embrace your differences and develop confidence in your uniqueness. Artist, Jamaal Eversley, through support from the Stoughton Cultural Council and the RTI Empowerment Center, calls on SHS students to create a piece of art to be exhibited during “The **BOLD** & **BEAUTIFUL**” Exhibition at the RTIEC (769 Washington Street in Stoughton, MA) in May 2019. For this exhibition, these outstanding works will explore the theme: “*The things that make me **BOLDLY** different, make me **BEAUTIFUL**!*”

The artwork should focus on your distinctive, recognizable personality traits. What makes you proud to be you? What makes you feel #blessed 🙏? Stoughton High School's students from grades 9-12 are eligible and encouraged to submit to this art exhibition. This exhibition is providing SHS students a public outlet for expression and communal participation. It will not be a requirement of a class that you submit to the exhibition. Resources and support will be provided by Jamaal Eversley at the Revolution To Inspire Empowerment Center (769 Washington St. Stoughton) on March 25th (Monday) and 27th (Wednesday) from 3pm - 4:30pm.

Who can participate in the call and exhibition?

Participation in “The **BOLD** & **BEAUTIFUL**” Exhibition is open to all Stoughton High School students:

- in grades 9 -12

The exhibition does not have academic and disciplinary standing requirements. Work created in the fall 2018 semester is eligible for submission, as long as the student hasn't already graduated. Students should submit in their current grade level.

What is the goal of “The **BOLD** & **BEAUTIFUL**” Exhibition?

This exhibition is an opportunity to broaden the students' creative horizons while earning local recognition during the exhibition at the RTIEC. The goal is to foster confidence of young artists plus give them the opportunity to be recognized for their creative achievements and for what makes them “**BOLD** & **BEAUTIFUL**”. Lastly, students who submit and complete the essay portion will have a chance to win “The **BOLD** & **BEAUTIFUL**” Award!
